Incident cards (face)

Incident 1


- Several children were found while visiting a supplier's factory.
- When asked what they are doing, one of the children say, "brought tea to our parents working in the factory."
- It was discovered later that the children were working full-time in the factory and not attending elementary school.
- The manager says that the children's families were very poor, and if left unchecked, they had no choice but to beggar or prostitute.

Incident 2

- An NGO investigation reveals that one of the supplier's sub-contractors (Tier 2 supplier) does not pay the minimum wage.
- They also use a 12-hour shift system with only two 10-minute breaks.
- There was a rumor that the some employees trying to unite were fired.



Lottery for assigning roles (maximum 7 people)

If there are fewer than 8 people, enter their names above the sticks in order from left to right.
The rightmost roles are lower in priority.



Settings and tips for printing cards:

Print with the settings “Double Sided,” “A4 Horizontal,” “Long Edge Binding (Top),” and “Color.” You can easily cut out the cards with scissors and align the face sides with the back sides.

Use the back side as the guide when cutting out the role cards.

Use the face side as the guide when cutting out the incident cards.
